

2024 TIMMS/ENGEN GRANT INFORMATION

The Timms-Engen Grant program invites application for post-secondary grants. For students graduating in June, 2024 there are 8 individual grants available. These are valued at \$5,000 each.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must:

1. be a current full-time student in the Surrey School District
2. have applied to attend full-time studies at a post-secondary institution during 2024-25. The post-secondary program can be academic, technical or trades training.
3. Have a Canadian SIN (Social Insurance card)

CRITERIA:

The grant will be awarded based on evaluation of the following criteria:

1. Financial Need
2. Personal reference letters from two staff members at their school
3. Student statement of future goals and ambitions
4. Student statement of current strengths

Grants are payable on proof of full-time registration at a post-secondary institution.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Students are to submit two references from two staff members at their current school indicating:

- a) their appraisal of the student's work ethic in their school classes
- b) their knowledge of any contributions the student has made to the school or broader community
